The Northwestern Medicine Discovery Program is intended to ignite a student's passion for the medical field by providing a comprehensive overview of the diverse career opportunities that are available in health care. Students are exposed to both traditional and non-traditional medical careers, and will learn practical skills as they navigate real-life hospital and patient-care scenarios to help them determine if a career in the medical field is right for them.

Students who are selected for the Discovery Program will have the unique opportunity to participate in activities facilitated by Northwestern Medicine physicians, clinicians and professional staff, including tours, presentations, group discussions and practical hands-on projects. The program also offers students opportunities for leadership, mentorship, networking and community service.

Students interested in participating in the Discovery Program must meet the following eligibility requirements. Space is limited.

- Sophomore or Junior in high school (two-year commitment)
- Minimum GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale and in good standing
- Entire application completed and submitted prior to due date
